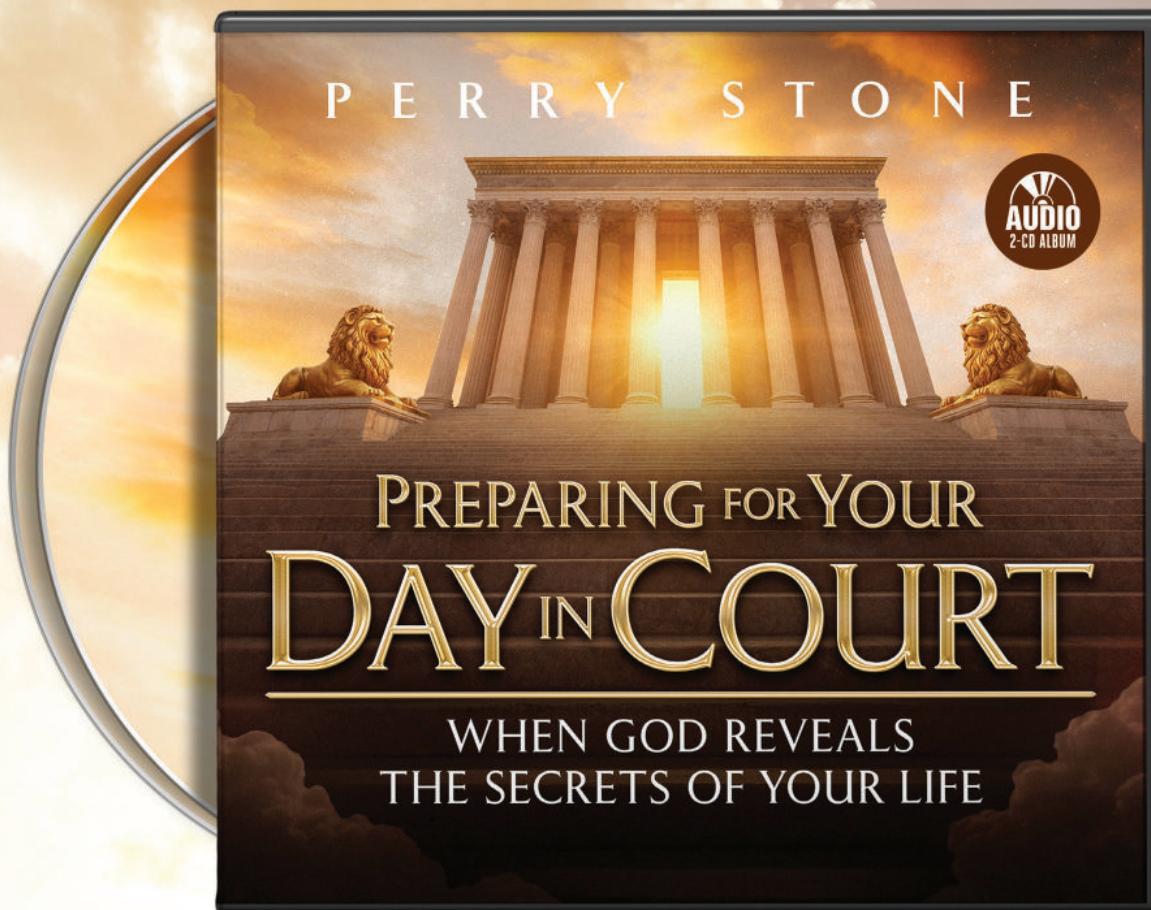

The remaining content is determined on a per-issue basis. After the articles are written and proofread, the content is laid out by our

Members of our VOE staff met recently to discuss our ministry outreaches that have brought into God's Kingdom the most significant harvest of souls. We also discussed areas where we are weaker and must do a better job.

It was noted that each month, our staff receives global reports of lives being transformed in nations of the world through the Manna-fest program, YouTube videos, and our various ministry outreaches. Yet, except for our two conferences at OCI, we seldom share details of these inspiring stories with friends and partners. Laugh and Live Longer

“A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones”
– Proverbs 17:22 (NKJV)

IN

1964, a Dr. Cousins was diagnosed with incurable crippling pain in his bones and joints. He checked into a facility and spent the entire day watching old comedy classics like Candid Camera and the Marx Brothers. He started to notice that ten minutes of hard laughter set him free from all pain for 2 hours. He continued this process and eventually laughed himself free from all physical pain.

A study on humor indicates that a good, hard laugh relaxes the muscles for up to 45 minutes. Laughing decreases stress hormones and increases the immune cells that fight sickness. Laughing increases blood flow and releases endorphins that create “feel good” emotions.

Abraham was 100 years old and his wife Sarah was 90 when their only biological son, Isaac, was born. Other people their age would have been grandparents or great grandparents. Sarah was barren, yet by a miracle of God, she conceived at age 90. The Hebrew name of Isaac is *Yitzhak*, which means, “he will laugh,” or “laughter.” In Ecclesiastes

3:4, Solomon wrote that there is “a time to laugh.”

On rare occasions, a minister will be waxing eloquent when he will make an innocent “bloop” that sends the congregation into fits of laughter. In the past, when the original copy of a church bulletin was prepared on a typewriter, funny mistakes were sometimes made. Here are a few comments and announcements from old church bulletins that will give you a chuckle:

- Potluck supper Sunday at 5:00 pm. Prayer and medication to follow.
- Weight Watchers will meet at 7 pm. Please use the large double doors at the side entrance.
- Don't let worry kill you. Let the church help.

- For those of you who have children and don’t know it, we have a nursery downstairs.

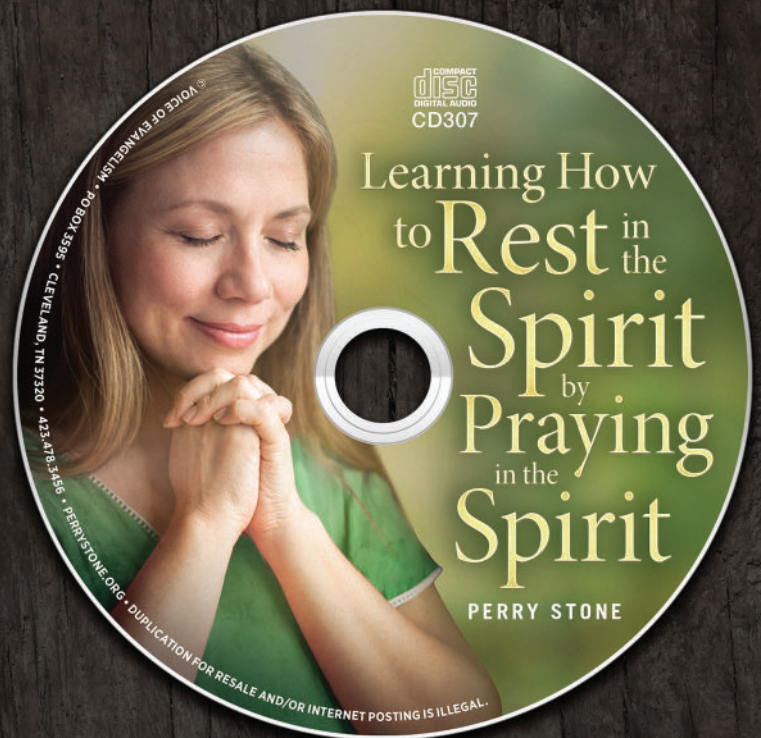
Here are some newspaper classified ads that someone should have edited before they were printed:

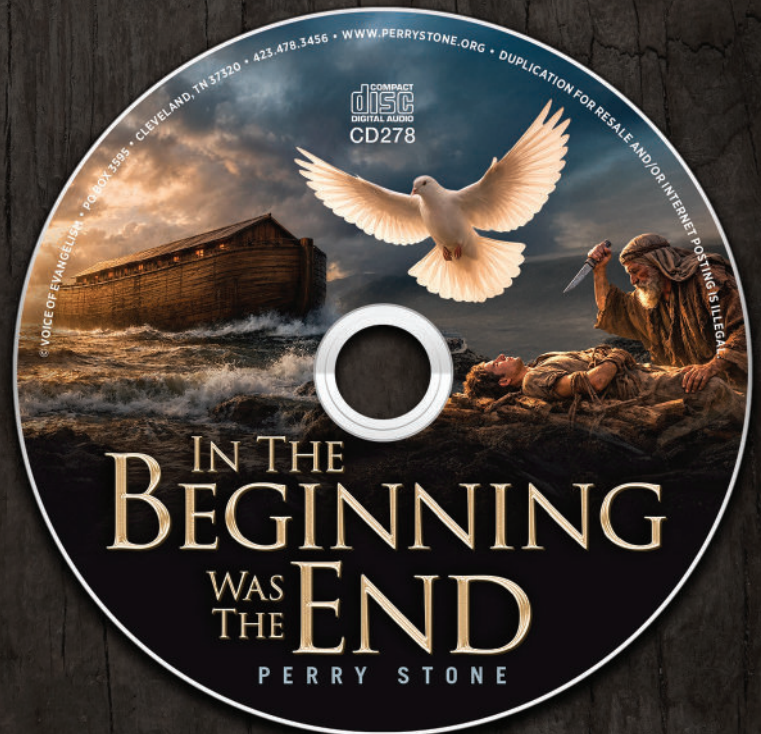

DO'S AND DON'TS FOR THE SEASONED SAINTS

NOW THAT I'M OVER THE AGE OF 60 and headed closer to 70, I have a perspective on aging that I didn't have twenty years ago. I realize that your spirit doesn't age, but your body certainly does. Here are some observations that I want to pass on to those who are in the same boat or headed there soon.

1. WATCH YOUR STEPS CAREFULLY

I used to say to my mother, "Be careful in the house not to trip over things, like rugs. You'll live longer if you can keep yourself from falling." Mom had her carpets cleaned one day, and the gentleman warned her to be careful because the carpets were still wet. Mom walked barefoot from the wet carpet in the family room to the vinyl floor in the kitchen, slipped because her feet were wet, and fell. She broke her wrist and ankle from the fall.

One time in Alabama, Pam turned out the lights and tripped over my bedroom slippers. That sent her to the

emergency room all night for a shoulder injury she suffered from the fall. About a year ago I was carrying a small glass case down some steps at my office steps, missed the last step, and found myself on the floor.

When Pam or I need someone to do something that requires standing on a ladder, we get someone younger and more agile to do the job. I refuse to let her climb a ladder and I won't climb one myself. There are times when we all have a forty-year-old's mind and a sixty-year-old's body. The mind says *go* and the body says *woe!*

As you get older, it becomes necessary to walk more cautiously, especially when you're walking down the stairs and finding things to trip over at home!

2. KEEP YOUR MIND ACTIVE

At age 84, my grandfather, John Bava, still had one of the sharpest and clearest minds of anyone I have known. He had a great memory, could recall hundreds of jokes and stories,



and remembered personal and ministry events from sixty years earlier that most family members had forgotten.

He engaged in several activities that I think kept his mind active. Sometimes he worked on crossword puzzles from magazines and newspapers. He enjoyed playing board games, and when our family visited, he pulled out Scrabble, Acquire (a real estate game), or Monopoly. He continually listened to cassettes and videos of messages. He had a religious broadcast on the radio, he pastored a church in Maryland for many years and drove back and forth from his home in West Virginia until he was in his late seventies. He also remained positive, didn't complain, even when he had reason to, and laughed a lot.

I know of two women in our town, both in their early 90s, who have good minds and are still active. They read a lot, work at home, and engage in conversations with other people. They also try to keep themselves from unhealthy stress and maintain a prayer life and the joy of the Lord. Keeping

your mind active is important in your later years.

3. SELL WHAT IS NOT NEEDED

Pam accuses me of being a hoarder, as I keep almost everything, including forty-year-old papers with "chicken scratch" notes on them. I still have the shirts I wore on Manna-Fest 20 years ago. I have thousands of books and other small items, some of which carry a unique memory. I think I'm more attached to the memories than to the objects.

About a year ago, I began working with my brother Phillip to gather a lot of these personal items so he can find buyers for these things. There comes a time in life when people realize the need to downsize. I'm also choosing to do this because I don't want to burden Pam or the children with all these things and have them wondering what they should do with all this stuff.

I have some items that have been set aside for my children and grandchildren, based upon Proverbs 13:22, "A good man

leaves an inheritance to his children's children." Becoming free from debt as much as possible is also an important aspect of freedom, especially in your later years.

4. ENJOY LIFE AND TRAVEL SOME WHILE YOU CAN

My mother drove to the office and worked at VOE until a month before she became sick and passed away. She was 85 years old. She knew that she couldn't just stay at home and do nothing. She enjoyed coming to work and connecting with other employees she worked with, and it kept her mind stimulated. Even after breaking her ankle and wrist, and after having a hip replacement, she still recovered and came to the office to work.

My father loved traveling and preaching. In his mid-seventies, his health and eyesight began to progressively and rapidly decline to the point that it was impossible for him to drive and preach. His life had been spent in ministry, and he felt that if he couldn't read the Bible or preach, he might as well go home and be with the Lord. He passed at age 78.

If you have the physical health and the income in retirement to take a trip occasionally, try to come to a conference and attend great ministry events while you are still able. So many of our faithful partners who never missed a meeting got to the point that they were no longer able to travel and could not continue to attend events. While you can, find a friend or family member who can join you in your journey, and make unforgettable memories.

I don't want to get to the point in my life that I say, "I would've, should've, could've done that, but now it's too late." Work on your bucket list and make some great memories. You worked your entire life, and now it's time to enjoy the fruit of your labor.

5. KEEP PLANTING SEEDS - EVEN WHEN THERE IS NO HARVEST

For almost 20 years, Pam and I did not stop praying the same prayers for our son Jonathan, that God would completely deliver him from addictions. When we gave an offering at church, I would say, “Target this offering in the spirit realm as a seed to help others, and in return God will help Jonathan.”

We prayed in faith when it seemed the prayers were bouncing off the ceiling. We loved Jonathan and tried to keep speaking words of faith, never wanting to give Satan an edge. We planted seeds of prayer and targeted our giving to build a heavenly memorial of prayers and giving before God’s throne (see Acts 10:1-4).

Paul taught that we must not become weary in doing good, as in due time we will reap from what we planted (Gal. 6:9). The reason for continuous planting is that you never know what seed will trigger the harvest. Solomon wrote:

“Cast your bread upon the waters, for you will find it after many days. Give a serving to seven, and also to eight, for you do not know what evil will be on the earth.” – Ecclesiastes 11:1-2 NKJV

If you were to plant seeds in one place, lack of rain or too much rain, lack of sunshine, and other circumstances could hinder the harvest. However, if seeds are planted in eight places, at some point one or more of the eight would produce the harvest. You must continue to plant seeds. Eventually, a divine reversal will happen swiftly and unexpectedly.

6. NEVER GIVE UP ON THE LOST

Many people have watched their children or grandchildren choose to follow the wrong influences, divorce their companion for another person, live alternative lifestyles, become addicted to dangerous drugs, or become incarcerated for criminal activity. Christian parents and grandparents live under a continual burden for their offspring, always aware of sudden dangers that

lie in the path of the rebellious child. However, it is important that you not allow the adversary to whisper in your ear that your prayers are not working and that your loved one will never return to God.

This is when you must rely on specific biblical promises that undergird your confidence and faith. Three of my favorite verses that I continually spoke over Jonathan are:

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. – Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV)

And they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household. – Acts 16:31 (NKJV)

For with God nothing shall be impossible. – Luke 1:37

If you are praying for a family member, take an index card and write their name on it. Then write these three scriptures (or others that you choose) on the card and place the card where you will see it every day, perhaps on the bathroom mirror or the refrigerator door. Each time you see the card, confess out loud the future salvation of that person. The enemy only wins if we stop praying and confessing that for which we are believing.

At times an unsaved family member will have to hit rock bottom or experience something negative or frightening to shift their attention back to God.

7. NEVER STOP LEARNING, EVEN IF YOU THINK YOU KNOW THE ANSWERS

I have spent my life reading the Bible, researching, studying, and writing. Yet, after almost 50 years of ministry, I still cannot say that I know everything about any one subject. The more I learn, the more I realize I don’t know.

Still, I don’t stop learning. My goal is to gain new insights that I might have missed in the past. I think it’s important

to never stop learning, and to never think that you already know everything.

It is also important to understand why other people do not believe as you do and what led them to their conclusions. I have studied Mormonism, Islam, and the beliefs of other religious groups to better understand why they believe as they do. The Apostle Peter wrote, “...always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear...” (1 Pet 3:15 NKJV).

There is always something new to learn every day. This is why we continue to create biblical content and prophetic insight through books, DVDs, CDs, magazines, and so forth.

I hope you will consider these seven suggestions. I believe they will help you better enjoy your later years. ❁



Guess Who is Becoming Weary and Fainting?

“He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall...”

– Isaiah 40:29-30 (NKJV)

THROUGHOUT THE WEEK, when I’m not traveling, I’m working at my Voice of Evangelism office. While I’m writing, reading and studying, I listen to videos on the internet. Sometimes it’s gospel music, nature sounds, preaching messages, or researchers who discuss the world’s present situations and strategies that are on the horizon. One troubling fact being discussed is that there is a younger generation that has completed a college education and now owes tens of thousands of dollars in student debt that they are unable to pay back because of the job market.

With my understanding of artificial intelligence and the fact that knowledge is doubling so rapidly, I assumed that the U. S. job market for those with a college degree would be secure, at least for the next 3 to 4 years, as their skills would be necessary to make the transitions.

Was I ever wrong! There are now thousands of people, including many in their twenties and early thirties, who are using social media to express their disdain for the job market, including job losses and positions being replaced by different forms of artificial intelligence.

Store closings (this has been happening since the extensive covid shutdowns), reductions of staff, and other corporate decisions are impacting many jobs. Some people state they have put in dozens of job applications, only to be rejected. The long-term plan, which tech industry executives have been talking about for years, is to replace employees with artificial intelligence and robotics.

Many college graduates are experiencing discouragement and even hopelessness. Imagine being in your twenties or thirties, and yet you cannot find work that aligns with your educational degree.


In the above text, Isaiah 40:29-30, the word *youth* is the Hebrew word *na’ar*, which alludes to the time from infancy to young adulthood. It would include those of college age. The word *faint* refers to a person becoming weary and exhausted; in this case, from the cares of life. The word *weary* alludes to a person who is exhausted to the point of gasping for air. Isaiah noted that this fainting and weariness would eventually cause the youth to stumble and fall.

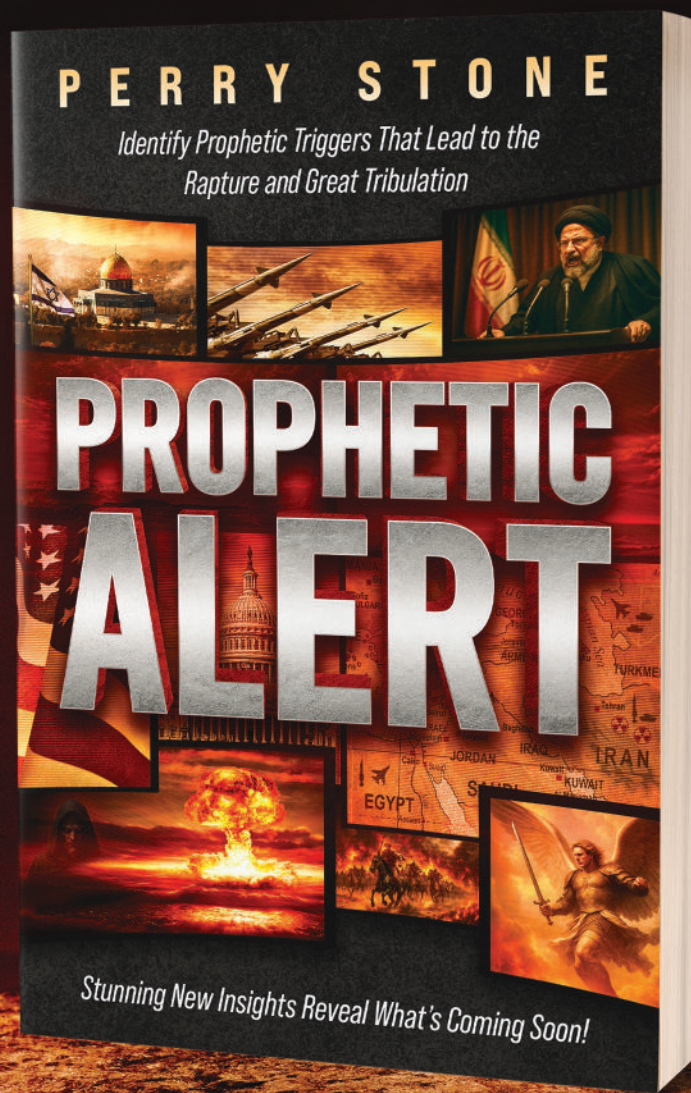
Paul wrote that we should not be “weary in well doing; for in due season we will reap if we do not faint” (Gal. 6:9).

Isaiah said that those who “wait” upon the Lord shall renew their strength, mount up with wings as eagles, run and not be weary, walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31). The word *wait* does not mean to sit idle as if waiting for someone to arrive. The root Hebrew word refers to “binding something together,” such as a binding of the heart to the expected intervention of God. It means to tarry with expectation.

Our Christian youth must renew their strength as they mount up as eagles and soar above their circumstances with the expectation that God will intervene and provide.

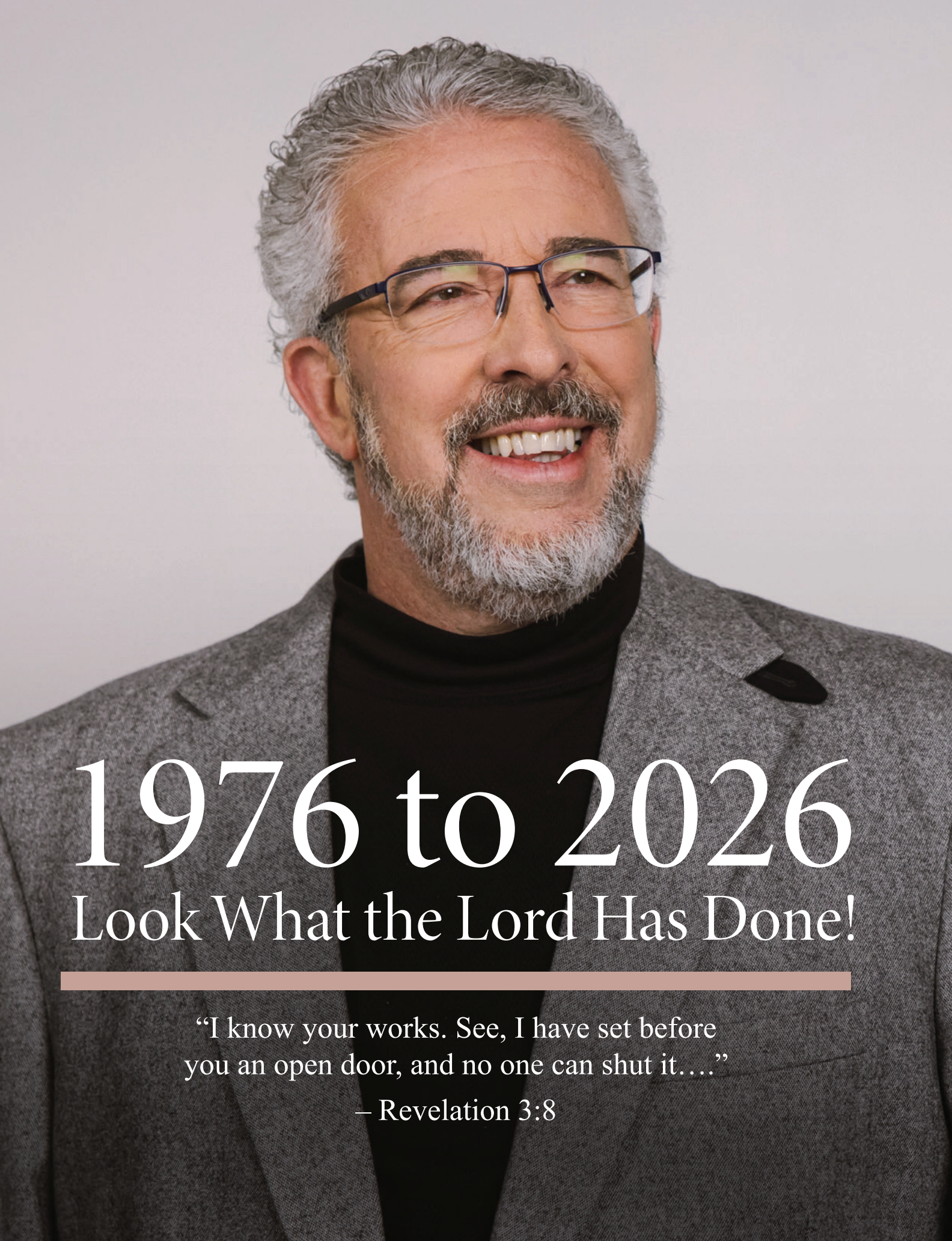
Let this also be a lesson to seek the will of God for your life early, before you spend money on a college degree that you will never use. We are entering an era when a trade job is becoming more valuable than many college degrees. Also, the lower quality of much higher education is causing more employers to reconsider the need for hiring people simply because they have a college degree. Determine your areas of interest and the natural skills and gifts you have and gear your future toward those areas. If you do that, there is a greater chance you will spend your life employed and doing things you love.

Look What the Lord Has Done!

“I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it....”

– Revelation 3:8

THE YEAR 1976 was when I began to occasionally travel to preach in small churches. During this time, I met Emmett Hinkley, a gifted minister, singer, and musician who owned and operated a small printing shop from the basement of his home. Emmett taught me about book writing, graphic layout, and methods to advertise our meetings and get our revival messages out to more people through printed resources and audio cassettes. I eventually traded my set of drums to Emmett to layout and print 500 copies of a book I had written titled, *Precious Promises for Believers*.

Around this time, I typed a small newsletter, made copies on a copy machine, and mailed it to people I knew. The first three copies were called “The Herald of Deliverance,” after the early 1960s magazine printed by T.L. Lowery. It was soon changed to *Voice of Evangelism*, a name which has continued since then.

In 1977, I was impressed to select the name *Voice of Evangelism* for the ministry, and at age 18 I focused on a “7-Point Outreach Plan.” This was also the beginning of the “7 a Month Club,” which was also the beginning of our monthly cassette (later CD) messages that were sent out for a seven dollar a month donation. The income was also used to help print and mail the *Voice of Evangelism* magazine.

When my parents moved from Salem, Virginia to Wildwood, Florida, I moved into an apartment in Northport, Alabama and sent my mail and orders to the home of Charlotte and Jerry Skelton, where Pam and her sisters were living. In April 1982, after marriage, Pam and I moved into a two-bedroom apartment in Cleveland, Tennessee. This is where God settled us to build an eventual worldwide ministry.

Here are some of the things God has done through the *Voice of Evangelism* ministry:

THE VOE OFFICES AND MINISTRY OUTREACHES

- Cassette duplication and mailing of resources was done from home in the early years.
- Needing more space, we rented a 350-square-foot office for duplication and shipping.
- Needing more space yet again, we moved into a 2,000-square-foot space for shipping and offices in downtown Cleveland.
- After outgrowing that, God provided a 7,800-square-foot building for offices and a video studio.
- Eventually, we outgrew that, purchased 20 acres of land, and built a 25,000 square foot office for VOE that included a studio, shipping, warehouse, and offices.
- Further growth required that we construct a 40,000-square-foot facility with a larger studio, editing suites, and additional offices.



- Over time, we added square footage to give extra storage to house ministry resources, and a project that included a secure center for backup computer systems and adequate storm protection.
- We purchased a large home for Woman of Hope, which is now a recovery center.
- We purchased property for ministry that is now a rehab and recovery center for people with addictions.

THE MAIN MINISTRY CENTERS

- Purchased 100 acres of land to build the Omega Center project
- Remodeled an old barn and used it for years as a prayer barn for weekly prayer meetings
- Constructed indoor and outdoor kitchens and restored pavilions for ministry events
- Constructed the beautiful outdoor Omega Center baptismal pool for water baptisms

- Constructed the 72,000-square-foot Omega Center International that is used for church services and conferences
- Built a beautiful three-story lodge style building for events, offices, and the Holy Land relic display
- Purchased the T.L. Lowery Global Foundation Center for the ISOW (International School of the Word) offices and the Global Prayer Center.

CONFERENCES AND EVENTS AT OMEGA CENTER

- The annual (at times twice yearly) Warrior-Fest, the youth reformation event with thousands attending
- The annual International Prophetic Summit that has drawn up to 4,000 attendees
- The annual Main Event, having been held each year since the fall of 1987 at different locations (before the OCI building was completed)
- Omega Center is used for special events by Karen

Wheaton, Bill Cloud, Judy Jacobs, and others.

- Perry Stone ministry has never charged a registration fee for the meetings and conferences we sponsor.
- During various seasons, ministry mentoring programs have been conducted at ISOW or OCI.

IMPORTANT MINISTRY OUTREACHES

- VOE sends free resource materials to people in prison.
- VOE has a special fund to support world missions, missionaries, and Lens of a Camera events.
- VOE tithes 10% of all non-designated donations to the Samaritan fund to assist the needy.
- VOE has supported Christians and Jews in Israel, particularly during the time of COVID and recent wars.
- VOE supports organizations that provide food and assistance to poor children during the Christmas season.
- VOE supports Queen for a Day, which ministers to poor women in town.

- VOE financially assists many churches, ministries, and missions programs each year.
- VOE has provided income each month to feed those in need throughout parts of America.
- VOE purchases gifts at Christmas for children who are part of the Boys and Girls Club in town.
- VOE provides financial assistance to several organizations in town that help the needy.
- VOE pays for Perry and his team members to travel to regional conferences and revivals throughout the U.S. This includes travel expenses, hotel rooms, rental costs of facilities or churches, and production costs required when organizing and setting up ministry events in other areas. 📍

JUNE OF 2026, Perry Stone will commemorate 50 years—a *Jubilee*—of evangelistic, traveling ministry. At age 16, Perry was directed by the Holy Spirit into the ministry of an evangelist. During that early season of his life, he was in tenth grade, attending

Andrew Lewis High School in Salem, Virginia. He preached his first message in April 1976 at the Salem Church of God where his dad served as pastor. At age 17, he was asked to preach a second time. This message lasted quite a long time. Perry said, “I think I quoted every scripture I knew in that one message.” The second message focused on the return of the Lord, which in years to come was a central theme of his prophetic teaching.

Perry’s ministry was considered “small beginnings.” His first revivals occurred in the summer of 1976, after receiving

an invitation to his grandfather John Bava’s church in Gorman, Maryland. He also preached in Rainelle, West Virginia and Starkey and Elliston, Virginia, with 10 to 50 people in attendance. In 1977, after graduating from high school, Perry began to travel and preach in five states. Soon he was preaching extended revivals, including three weeks in Montcalm, West Virginia, two weeks in Weyanoke, West Virginia, and two weeks in Pulaski, Virginia.

At age 18, after a time of fasting and prayer, he was given the inspiration to initiate a “Seven-Point Outreach Plan” designed to reach people outside the doors of the local church. The strategy included the use of radio, television, books, magazines, revivals, auditorium meetings, and other forms of ministry outreaches. The seven points were printed on the back covers of the first six ministry booklets he published: *Precious Promises for Believers*, *Heaven—Location*,

Destination; The Cause and Cure for Fear and Worry; The Blessing and Curse of Anointed Music; Satanic Influence in America; and 100 Percent Proof, Evidence of the New Wine. During nearly fifty years of ministry, Perry has written over 100 booklets and books, including best sellers that received awards through Charisma publishing for the “Charismatic Book of the Year.” The landmark point of Perry’s research and writing was the seven-year project to research and complete a commentary on the Old and New Testaments.

Perry’s revivals became almost legendary in towns such as Pulaski, Virginia, LaFollette, Tennessee, and Daisy, Tennessee. At times, these and other revivals drew the largest attendance in the church’s history, continuing nightly for many weeks and reaping a harvest of hundreds of people saved and baptized in the Holy Spirit. The evangelistic anointing is still evident, as in 2023 when Perry preached at Free Chapel in Gainesville, Georgia and saw a city revival that continued for fifteen nights. People packed the church to participate in this end-time outpouring. A similar outpouring followed in May of 2024 at Seven Hills Church in Kentucky, where in nine services, hundreds of people accepted Christ and many others received the infilling of the Holy Spirit.

During almost fifty years of ministry, Perry has preached thousands of messages behind church pulpits throughout 42 states in the U.S. and several countries outside of America. The spiritual results are difficult to track, especially since the weekly telecast is viewed by millions of individuals globally. We are certain that conservatively, hundreds of thousands of people have repented and accepted Christ, along with tens of thousands who have been filled with the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

The completion of Omega Center International has been a highlight for Perry’s ministry. The facility was miraculously paid for by the day it opened



for the first conference. Originally, services were held each Tuesday night in the small hall, but in 2018, the Tuesday services were moved to the larger OCI hall. Today, the local OCI ministry is under the dynamic leadership of Dr. Bryan Cutshall.

Prior to and for several years after the completion of OCI, Thursday evening prayer was held in the upper loft of the remodeled barn, where each one-hour prayer gathering could be viewed live over the internet. Those watching could send in prayer requests, which at the time were printed on paper and handed out to the intercessors to pray for the requests. Due to some of the elderly being unable to climb stairs and others being in wheelchairs, and the hot summers followed by cold winters, weekly prayer was moved to the smaller OCI hall. Eventually, a beautiful prayer set was built on the platform of the sanctuary at ISOW, where each Thursday global prayer continues with OCI fellowship members and friends, all forming a united team of dedicated intercessors who pray for the needs of those who submit prayer requests. Instead of printing prayer requests on

paper, they are now shown on screens throughout the room so people can pray as the requests come up on the screen.

Dr. Bryan Cutshall was pastoring a large, thriving congregation named Twin Rivers Church in St. Louis, Missouri before he moved to the Cleveland area. Eventually he and Perry teamed up to organize a new Internet Bible Teaching and Ministry School called the International School of the Word, or ISOW. The school presently has enrolled over 10,000 students across the nations. The T.L. Lowery Global Foundation building is the headquarters of the Bible School and the location of Thursday night global prayer.

Perry turns 67 on June 23, 2026. Lord willing, he plans to continue writing, teaching, preaching, traveling, and accomplishing the outreaches God has placed in his heart. The prayers of so many and the dedicated and faithful support of each person who sows what they can to assist VOE, ISOW, and OCI have made 50 years of soul winning possible. May your reward be great in heaven for taking our hands and walking with us on this amazing journey of faith! 🙏

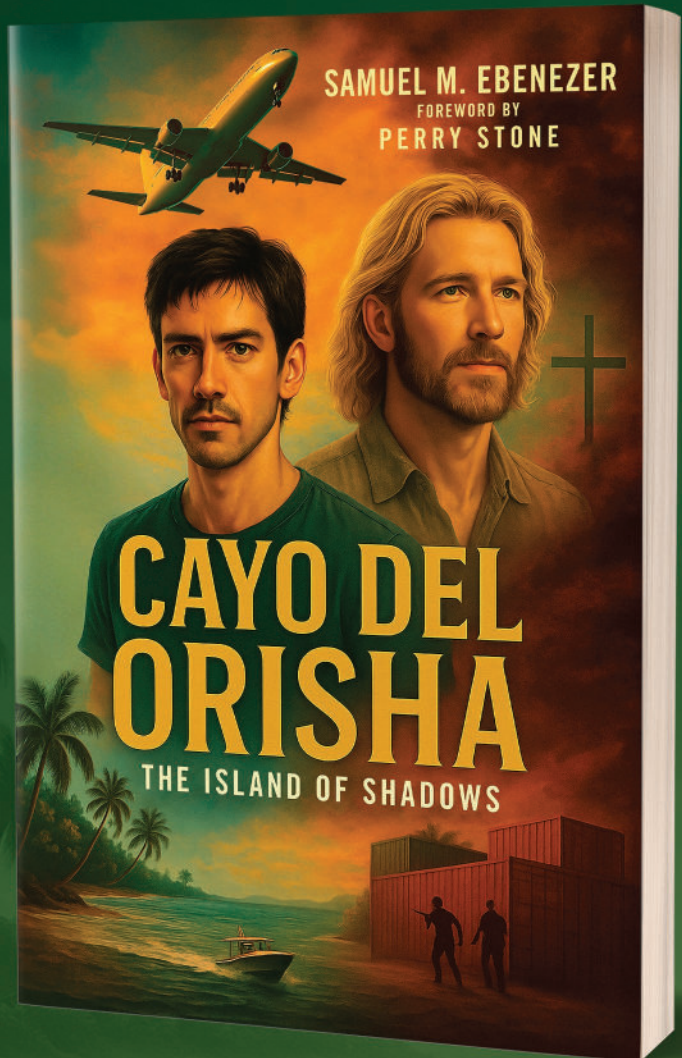

THE LANDSCAPE OF FAITH in the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is witnessing a profound shift as the ministry of Dr. Perry Stone continues to leave an indelible mark on the region. Through massive open-air crusades and a commitment to humanitarian relief, thousands of lives are being transformed spiritually and physically.

A HARVEST OF SOULS AND HEALING

The atmosphere at the recent open-air crusades has been described as electric. As Dr. Stone delivers powerful Gospel messages, the response has been overwhelming, with hundreds of thousands of souls reportedly making decisions for faith.

However, it is the tangible “signs and wonders” that have captivated the local communities. Eyewitnesses share accounts of individuals arriving at the crusade grounds on cots, unable to walk, only to stand and return home on their own feet following prayers for healing. Reports of restored sight—including those blind in one or both eyes—and the sudden disappearance of chronic ailments like cancer, tuberculosis, and diabetes have become hallmarks of these gatherings. Perhaps most touching are the testimonies of hundreds of families who, after struggling with infertility for 10 to 25

years, are now celebrating the arrival of “miracle babies.”

BREAKING THE CHAINS OF POVERTY

Beyond the pulpit, the ministry is tackling systemic injustice through direct action. In a region where generational debt often leads to modern-day slavery, the ministry’s intervention on behalf of these families has been life changing.

By paying off the debts of enslaved families, Perry Stone Ministries isn’t just offering a prayer; it is offering a new life. These rescue missions provide a comprehensive “fresh start” package, including full slave debt liquidation, three months of essential groceries, three months of paid house rental, and the purchase of vehicles that are needed to provide families with a different and sustainable means of income.

A LASTING LEGACY

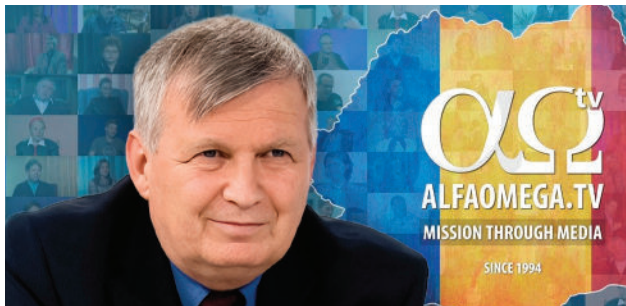

THE MAIN ACTIVITY of Alfa Omega Media Ministries is related to video production, broadcast, and distribution of Christian content. Our identity and calling are summarized by two ideas:

- We are a Light in the Darkness
- We are doing Missions through Media.

From the beginning, Alfa Omega was known as the Christian videos, films, documentaries, and children's program distributor to many commercial and secular TV channels all over Romania. A yearly average of 30 local, secular, and broadcast TV stations was part of this unusual distribution network of Christian content through secular media channels! Until 2012 the National Religious Broadcasters honored this effort two times by allocating the NRB International Awards to Alfa Omega Media Ministries.

After getting the license from CNA (National Audiovisual Council - similar to FCC in US) in December 2005, later in 2006 was launched the "Alfa Omega TV" satellite channel on Eutelsat 12 degrees, a 24/7 "free-to-air" channel covering Europe, North Africa, and part of the Middle East. It was the first Christian channel on satellite in the Romanian language. There are even now, after almost 20 years of non-stop broadcast, many program slots with films, documentaries, children's programs, talk shows, and many pre-evangelistic programs; also, some ministry programs from Romania or from abroad.

For almost 10 years now, one of the ministry programs from outside Romania is "Manna-Fest" with Perry Stone, aired by us on a weekly basis and covering Biblical teachings, revelations, end-time perspectives, Israel, and spiritual warfare.

From 2010 the channel is listed by CNA (National Audiovisual Council) in the "must-carry" list of TV channels, and it's included in all the Romanian cable TV networks. That means that approximately 75% of the Romanian population have access to this channel, by cable TV networks, available in their homes. Additional viewers can have access to the channel or to different programs by many social media platforms, mobile apps, and direct satellite access.

In addition to the main broadcast, Alfa Omega developed very large and numerous social media channels, websites, mobile app, a publishing house, and a printed magazine (Alfa

Omega TV Magazine). The printed/online magazine is, at this time, the largest one in the Romanian language.

Especially in the last year, we started to translate and publish in Romanian several books by Perry Stone. The following books, now available in Romanian, many for giveaway, have a very strong impact among spiritual leaders:

- Secrets of the Third Heaven
- The Final Ciphers
- Artificial Intelligence versus God
- Your Journey into Eternity
- Purge your Home, Prune your Generational Tree

All the financial support from VOE (“Voice of Evangelism International Ministries”) for Alfa Omega Media Ministries was considered by our team as special blessings, a special seed in our mission through media. All the donations received by us 2-3 times per year from VOE were used to cover the following areas of costs:

- subtitling work into Romanian for many foreign programs, including Manna-Fest
- satellite/broadcast operations (uplink, links, internet, scheduling, archiving)
- production cost for our own programs

- taxes to the government (increased a lot in the last years)

So, as VOE and as financial partners you are a part of what God doing in this part of the world, helping us to reach Romanians for Christ, equipping and preparing the Body for His second coming. Thank you so much, dear friends and VOE partners. You are helping us to fulfill His call for us in such a time as this.

The majority of the Romanian population (almost 20 million in total) is Orthodox as a belief system (80%) and only 5% are Evangelicals. That means up to 1 million evangelical believers, in total more than all the believers for the other East European countries all together. Spiritually it is a huge potential for the Body [of Christ] in Romania, and I believe God will use Romania, including Alfa Omega as a media voice, to restore Christian values in this part of the world.

Recently one guest of our studio, talking in a program about Romania, said our country is “a Gideon country” against all voices that will say: “What good could come out from Romania?”

At this point Romania is at the end of the list of European countries. But God! 🙏

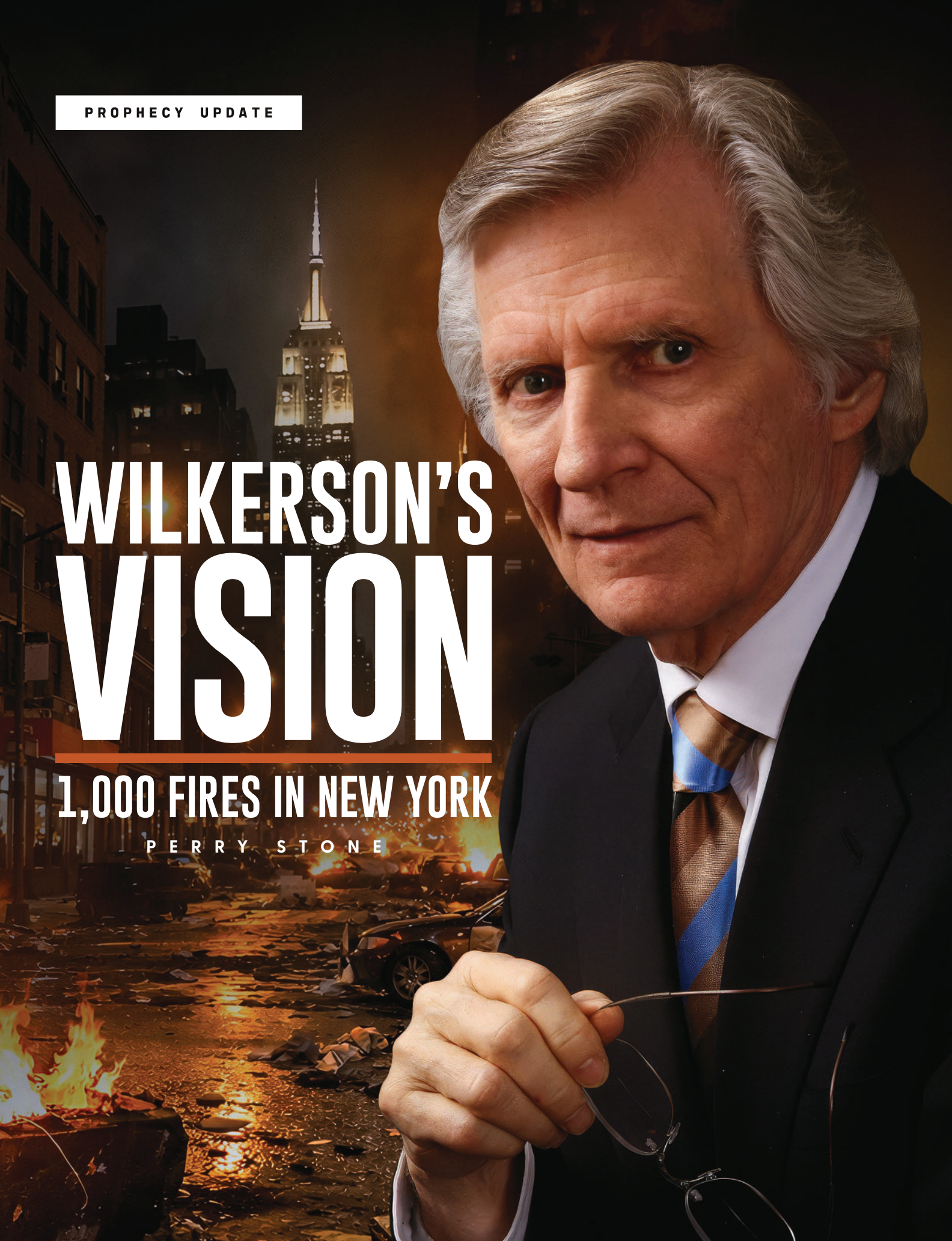

PROPHECY UPDATE

WILKERSON'S VISION

1,000 FIRES IN NEW YORK

P E R R Y S T O N E



MANY OF YOU are familiar with the name David Wilkerson. In the 1950s, he was a noted street preaching evangelist who focused on ministering the message of Christ to gangs members in New York City. When gang leader Nicky Cruz was converted, revival came to the gangs and Wilkerson's name became known throughout the city and the United States.

Wilkerson wrote a best-selling book, *The Cross and the Switchblade*, that reached many young people in his day. The story was later produced into a movie. David, in later years, became pastor of Times Square Church in New York City. He had a heart for the many unsaved people from various nations who formed the melting pot of nationalities living in the city.

In 1985, Wilkerson wrote a book, *Set the Trumpet to Your Mouth*, which was a warning for America and the church. What he penned was a burning prophetic and biblical warning of sin in the church, which he compared to ancient Israel breaking their covenant with the Almighty. He warned of some things that have not yet occurred. However, events throughout the world make these warnings more possible than ever before. He wrote:

“America is going to be destroyed by fire! Sudden destruction is coming and few will escape. Unexpectedly, and in one hour, a hydrogen holocaust will engulf America – and this nation will be no more.” He later wrote that following an attack from Russia, “The great holocaust follows an economic collapse.” The reason was, “The enemy will make its move when we are weak and helpless...America will not repent...”

THE 1,000 FIRES IN NEW YORK

On September 7, 1992, Wilkerson preached:

“I have had a recurring vision of over 1,000 fires burning at one time in New York City. I am convinced race riots will soon explode. New York is right now a powder keg ready to blow. Federal and state welfare cutbacks will be the spark that ignites the fuse...100,000 angry men will be on the streets, enraged because they have been cut off from benefits...fires will rage everywhere...”

Wilkerson released another public warning in March of 2009:

“An earth-shattering calamity is about to happen...it is going to be frightening...we are all going to tremble, even the godliest among us... Major cities all across America will experience riots and blazing fires such as we saw in Watts,

Los Angeles years ago... There will be riots and fires in cities worldwide...there will be looting...”

These are just a few of the statements and written warnings that Wilkerson gave, prior to his death in an auto accident in East Texas on April 27th, 2011. Years ago while ministering in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, I mentioned some of these warnings. After the service, a man who was familiar with Wilkerson told me the following:

“David Wilkerson was told these warnings by an angel of the Lord that visited him. He would never say he saw an angel, as he knew people would probably not believe him. He would say the Lord showed him this was coming...”

HOW COULD THIS OCCUR?

When the government shuts down, it impacts government programs and the financial assistance inner city families depend on. Should another deadly terrorist attack occur, or an event such as an electromagnetic pulse bomb that shuts down the power grid in the city, mobs of people and roving gangs would likely create chaos for the entire city. We have already observed fires burning in American cities, set by dangerous and radical groups who use violence to gain support for their political, social, and cultural demands.

Time will reveal when and how these visions and predictions will occur. Wilkerson was considered by mature Christians to be a prophetic voice in his generation. Years ago, I received a call from his ministry telling us that he followed our prophetic ministry. I was honored and humbled to hear this.

May God continue to raise up true, biblical voices that are anointed with divine insights to lead the people of God in the Word in these seasons. ☪

My Friend Gideon Shor

EACH WEEK, THE MINISTRY STAFF RECEIVES the sad word that a ministry partner, a close friend, or perhaps a pastor we have been in fellowship with for decades has passed from this life and is present with the Lord.

Recently, I received word from Israel that my long-time tour guide and dear friend of 40 years, Gideon Shor, passed away in October. Gideon was a personal Israeli tour guide to many noted people, including owners of the Patriot's football team, Robert and Myra Kraft; Norman Lear; Hubert Humphrey; and a host of celebrities and politicians. His information was like listening to a Middle East historian or biblical scholar explain in simple terms the history of Israel and prophecies of the Bible. He knew detailed facts about every inch of Israel. He was my primary tour guide from 1985 until 2018.

Gideon stayed in our home when he visited the U.S. We would travel to churches and homes, telling Israel stories and encouraging people to visit the Holy Land. What I loved about him the most was his kind spirit and his concern that every person in my tour group was being cared for and was enjoying their tour.

Gideon believed that Christ fulfilled the Messianic prophecies, and he was a man who appreciated prayer and had a great love for the Bible. I believe our friendship had an influence on his life, as I hope it does to all our friends who live in the Holy Land. He will be missed, but his biblical insight will continue through our ministry for as long as I am preaching.

1988 Prophecy Being Fulfilled Now

IN NOVEMBER OF 2025, I was reminded of a supernatural dream that occurred in November of 1988. I was sound asleep, when suddenly I found myself standing in the back of a small, cinderblock church that I perceived to be a church that I had helped build somewhere overseas. I heard the Lord's voice speaking to me from the platform near the pulpit area. I cannot remember everything that was spoken, but I clearly heard the last statement: "All I am going to tell you now is Psalm 2:8!" I awoke and looked up Psalm 2:8. It reads:

"Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession." - Psalms 2:8

The Hebrew word *heathen* in this verse is *goy* which is used to describe Gentiles, or non-Jewish nations and people. This prophetic word was given twelve years before we launched the Manna-Fest program around the world. Up to that point (1988), I had not ministered overseas. I had only traveled to Israel for tours. In the past 25 years, we have now reached the majority of continents and most major nations through cable, satellite, and internet.

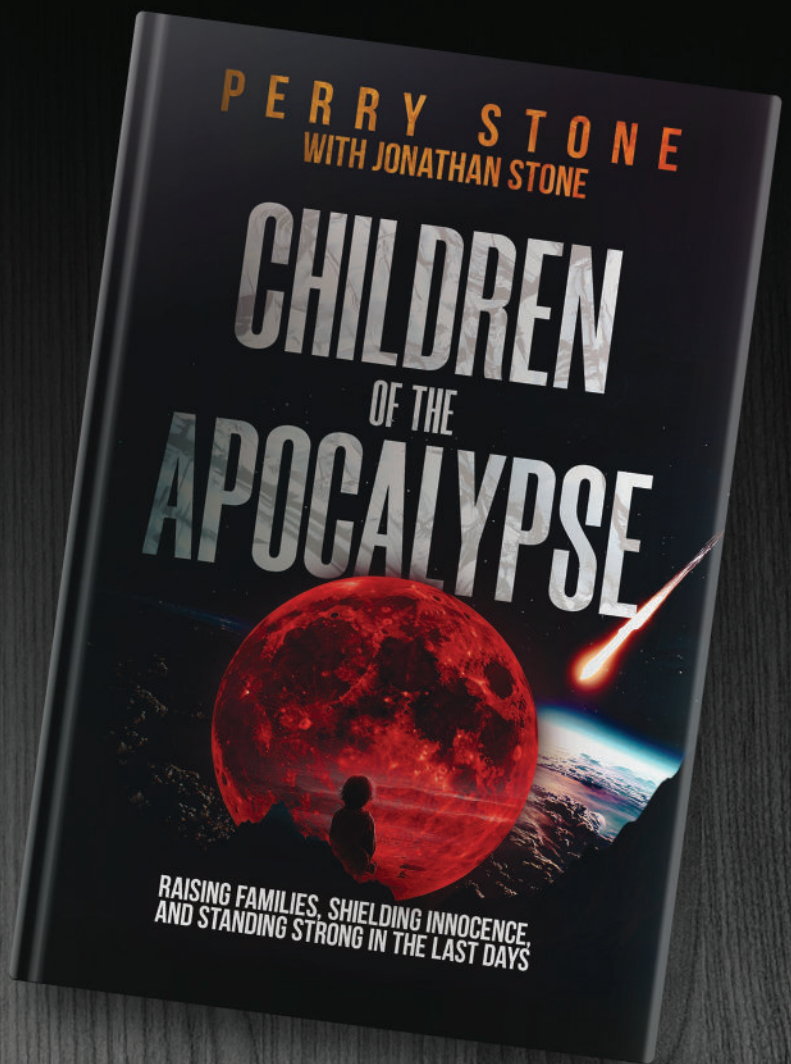
Christ said the Gospel would go into "Judea, Samaria, and the uttermost parts of the earth" (Acts 1:8). The word *uttermost* refers to the farthest islands and nations existing on earth. This includes places within the 10/40 window where many people still have never heard a clear Gospel message. During the past 25 years, through the VOE ministry, you have helped us reach hundreds of millions of people from all nations. Your and my spiritual inheritance is the souls we are winning to Christ!

Do This While You Can

ONE OF MY GREAT JOYS is seeing ministry partners, both old and new friends, who choose to take a few days away from the cares of life and join the VOE family at one or all of our three yearly conferences. At each event, around 40% are first time guests, while the remaining 60% are friends who enjoy these gatherings so much that they set aside time each year to attend.

It takes much effort to plan and prepare to attend Warrior-Fest, the Prophetic Summit, and the Main Event. However, in many ways we are blessed. Consider what the average family in Christ's time went through to attend an outdoor meeting where Christ was ministering. One lad brought a lunch, knowing the service could extend late into the day (Matt. 14:17). People had to carry their loved ones, some who were diseased, possessed, or unable to walk, as they traveled for many miles across rough terrain by foot, carts, or donkeys and came seeking a miracle. There were no public restrooms and no cafes at the outdoor events, and at times the ministry services continued for many hours, meaning people had to sleep outdoors.

The woman with the issue of blood had to press forward and ignore the possibility that she could be stoned for breaking the rules of the sick being in public (Mark 5:25-30). Remembering what people went through, just to get to Jesus, helps us realize that we are blessed to participate in an end-time move of the Spirit.

Translated into Russian and Romanian Languages

SEVERAL OF OUR BOOKS have now been translated and printed in both the Russian and Romanian languages. The Manna-Fest telecast is being translated into the Romanian language, with a potential of reaching 16 million individuals. It is also translated into the Russian language and aired in the Ukraine and throughout Russia, in 11 different time zones. Through the assistance of Rick Renner Ministries, we also have a strong Russian YouTube channel. Books translated into the Russian language are being distributed to those seeking truth. One book the people are enjoying is titled, *Exposing Satan's Playbook*.

If you've attended any of our regional or OCI conferences, you likely have seen videos sent to us from different nations

with personal testimonies from men and women who received Christ after watching the Manna-Fest telecasts. It is impossible to estimate the number of men, women and youth who are receiving Christ as Messiah through watching the programs. We also have a strong Russian - Jewish audience inside of Israel.

Always remember that your prayers and steadfast financial support are significant in reaching millions of people around the world. I used to tell people to "work for the crown." One day those who supported ministries that reach the lost around the world will also receive a crown for their part in winning multitudes of people across the globe to Christ.
